Endoplasmic Reticulum: I understand that vesicles can travel between the cis face of the Golgi back to the rough ER through the process of retrieval. My question however is whether or not it is possible for vesicles to travel from the stacks of the Golgi back to the rough ER or any other place outside the Golgi?

My impression is that traffic within the stack itself doesn't end up going somewhere else outside the "world" of the Golgi. Sorting happens at the trans face and retrieval happens at the cis face.
