

*The Cell Cycle and Events of M-Phase: During Anaphase B, I understand that kinesins cause the MT to move to opposite directions. However, how do dyneins play a role in the movement as well?*

Yes, dyneins are "pulling" the astral MTs (and consequently the entire centrosome) closer to the cell membrane, further separating the centrosomes so that cytokinesis occurs without a problem.
