Students seeking experience in plant biology, agronomy, synthetic biology, genetics, environmental sciences, chemical engineering, and civil engineering are welcome to apply!

The Plan: Students will be paired with a CABBI mentor, conduct research, attend career development seminars, learn about the graduate school application process, and practice STEM communication by presenting research at a summer symposium. Projects will be virtual unless on-campus work is deemed safe.
