APPLICATION

Find out about the Illinois undergraduate pre-selection process at the <u>Mayo Clinic and Illinois Alliance</u> <u>website</u>. Then, complete the <u>online pre-selection application</u> and submit all materials by December 1, 2017.

ELIGIBILITY

Urbana campus undergraduates who are currently in their sophomore or junior year, with a minimum 3.0 GPA are eligible to apply.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

A \$6,000 stipend will be awarded in part by the student's home department and the Mayo Clinic & Illinois Alliance to cover living expenses in either Rochester, MN or Jacksonville, FL during the 10-week program.

SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION

Representatives of the Illinois Steering Committee will select up to seven Urbana campus undergraduates. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision on January 18, 2018. Successful applicants must use the same application materials to complete Mayo Clinic's formal online application prior to the hard deadline of February 1, 2018. All applicants are strongly encouraged to submit their applications to the Mayo Clinic's online application system in addition to applying through the Illinois pre-selection process.
