As students are beginning to think about summer courses at Parkland, I hope you will join me in encouraging early planning. Students who have never taken courses at Parkland will need to complete the application as a non-degree student. All students will then complete the appropriate Parkland Concurrent Enrollment form: <u>Domestic or International</u>. For students receiving financial aid, they should also complete the <u>Financial Aid Concurrent Enrollment</u> form.

The Parkland Summer schedule is now available online. Students/advisors can easily search for available courses at Parkland right from the <u>home page</u> by clicking "Search for Classes" on the left toolbar. Open registration for all students will begin on April 3.

If a student wishes to take a math course, or a course that has math as a prerequisite (e.g. CS or Physics), they must show proof of the prerequisite completed through their Academic History (not DARS audit) or ALEKS scores (a screenshot suffices). If they do not have either, they will be required to take Parkland's math placement test. The break down for the Parkland ALEKS cutoffs follows (scores are valid for two-years):

The relationship between Parkland and the University of Illinois has been in place for almost 50 years and works very well, but if Illinois students do not apply and get admitted, they will receive no special treatment (e.g. priority or rush processing so that they can register). **They should apply early in the case that they are even thinking of taking a course**.
